Greetings!

After an enjoyable summer vacation, the school reopened on Monday, 01st July, 2019 and we have begun with the regular classes. Now, I would like to apprise you of the forthcoming activities of the school and brief you about the events that were held in the recent past.

Staff Changes: Mrs. Manjuka Barua, TGT superannuated on 30th June, 2019 after rendering 22 years of her services to the institution. We wish her all the best for the days to come. **New Staff Member:** Mr. Soumya Kant Mishra, TGT joined the school in July, 2019. We welcome the new appointee to the Xavier Family.

Senior Inter House Play Festival both English & Hindi were held on 23rd and 24th July, 2019 respectively. All the four houses put up a spirited performance. It gave them an opportunity to showcase their talent in acting.

Feast of St. Ignatius of Loyola, the founder of the Society of Jesus, will be celebrated on Tuesday, 30th July, 2019 during the special assembly. Kindly keep the Jesuits all over the world in your prayers.

The Periodic Test will begin on Monday, 05th August, 2019 and will get over by Saturday, 10th August, 2019. The timetable is given overleaf. Since the duration of the exam is 1½ hours and the exam gets over at 9:40 a.m., students are allowed to go home after the test. Kindly make arrangements for the transportation for your ward accordingly. **It is mandatory for all the students to appear for the test. There is no provision for re-test.**

Academic Achievements: Our students have done extremely well in academics. The CBSE results of Std. X and XII were very good. In class XII, 65 students out of 311 have scored 90% and above. Three of our students came out with flying colours in the Board Exam. Bhavya Gupta of XII-B (Commerce stream) scored 98.40%, Vinita Shekhawat of XII-F (Humanities stream) scored 96.60% and Naman Madhav Sogani of XII-D (Science stream) scored 95.80%. Congratulations to the stream toppers and all the students. In class X, 93 students out of 312 scored 90+ marks and while 87 students got between 80..90%. Aditya Gupta is the school topper; he got 98.60%. It is heartening to know that some of our students have secured admission in professional institutions like IIT, Engineering and Medical Colleges of high repute. Our compliments to all the staff members and the meritorious students.

To promote and instill a feeling for the representation of their respective house and sportsmanship at an early age, from July, 2019 the students are allowed to wear their house T-shirts once a week on Wednesdays as part of the summer uniform.

Similarly on Wednesdays and Thursdays (*normal working*) after school, the teachers will remain till 02:15 p.m. for helping the students in clearing their doubts pertaining to academics. Please make use of the opportunity. Those students staying back must make their transport arrangement accordingly.

Sports: Swimming: Our students participated in the Junior / Sub-Junior State level Swimming Championship held at Shahpura in May 2019. They bagged 39 gold, 16 silver and 13 bronze medals. Four swimmers have set 9 new records and four swimmers participated in the National Level Championship held at Rajkot. In the Senior District Swimming Championship held at Chaugan Stadium, Jaipur, swimmers won 19 gold, 13 silver and 12 bronze medals. 8 swimmers were selected for State Championship to be held at Kota. **Table Tennis:** Aditya Jain secured 4th rank in Rajasthan. **Shooting:** Hemangi Singh Deora participated in the Nationals. **Chess:** 5 students participated in the Nationals **Basketball:** Kritvarya Pratap Singh participated in the Nationals (U_14). Accolades to all the students and their coaches for the outstanding performance!

Punctuality and regularity are the main aspects of school life that we insist upon. Children must report to school well ahead of time in order to attend the morning assembly. Above all, we request you to insist your wards on their regular hard work at home in order to ensure not merely success in the examinations but in all activities of the school – curricular and co-curricular.
